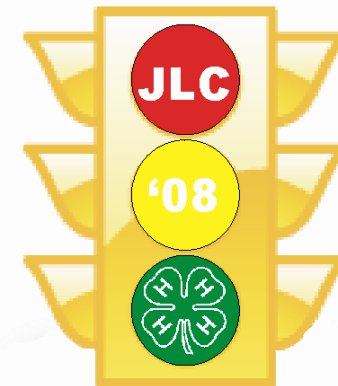
A limited number of 4-H scholarships are available - applications and deadlines are posted on the State 4-H website noted above.

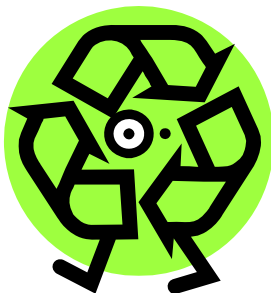
